



Withdrawal2

- 1. One clear calendar month's notice in writing or a month's fees in lieu of such notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.
- No fee other than security deposit is refundable at any stage.
- Transfer Certificates will not be issued until all dues of the school are settled.
- Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:
- Disciplinary
- Unsatisfactory progress in academics
- the school leaving examination and are under eighteen years of age. Where a withdrawal takes place due to the above reasons, the questions of charging month's fee in lieu of the notice does not arise.

5. As a rule only those students will be retained on the roll of the school who can take



The official Application Form, attached with this brochure, must be completed and registered by paying the Registration fee, which is not refundable. Admissions, where vacancies exist, are made on the basis of an entrance examination/interview. Those children who are registered will be notified of the date of the examination. After examining the child, the Principal reserves the right to admit the child in the class deemed suitable for him/her. No

- 1. Registration Forms have to be filled in and submitted to the school office before the end of the Registration period.
- MO 2. Incomplete or illegible Registration Forms, or without photographs will not be processed/accepted. 3. Dates for test/interview/interaction will be given at the time of registration. The school authorities reserve the right to change the date and time of the interview.
 - 4. Mere issue of form or registration does not imply admission which is subjected to Admission Tests/interviews/interaction and also to the availability of seats.
 - Photocopy oi birth certificate issued by Municipal Corporation or Concerned Civic Authority must accompany the Registration Form for all classes. Photocopy of report card of the last exam passed must be attached with the Registration Form for classes I and above.
 - 6. Age of admission for class Mont-I is 2+years as on 1st April of the academic session in which admission is being sought. Age should be properly specified on the forms. Request for relaxation of age criterion will not be entertained.

No direct admissions to class 10th and 12th except approved transfer cases.

- Parents/Guardians concerned shall be informed when a child is selected for admission. However, the offer shall be treated as confirmed only if the fees and security deposit have been paid within the stipulated
- If a child does not join the school at the stipulated time even after admission has been confirmed, then full school fees for the year are chargeable, since that seat would have been denied to other eligible child.



For a child who has been to a school previously and is attending this school for the first time, a Transfer Certificate from the previous school must be furnished before joining the school. However, a birth certificate will be mandatory even if the DOB is mentioned on the transfer certificate. The date of birth once entered in the Admission Register will NOT he altered under any circumstances. On withdrawal, a Transfer Certificate will be issued if a no due certificate has been given and all fees have been paid according to the school rules.

Security Deposit

The school will refund the security deposit along with the settlement of the student's account, provided there are no outstanding amounts payable to the school by the parent concerned. In cases where there are outstanding amounts, the security deposit will be adjusted against their amounts. Security deposit is refundable only after submitting the security receipt. PLEASE KEEP THE SECURITY RECEIPT SAFE. After the security deposit has been refunded, if the cheque is not encashed within six months, no claim will be entertained thereafter.

- The annual charges for the year should be fully paid in advance at the time of admission/ beginning of the school year and the monthly fees will be payable in advance as per schedule given in the student handbook. Students whose fees have not been paid in full will not be permitted to join the school or continue on the rolls of the school.
- All payments must be made by the due date specified in the student handbook and circulars given from time to time. Anyone not clearing arrears within the stipulated time will be required to pay a surcharge of INR 50/- per day. NO APPLICATION FOR REMISSION OF THE SURCHARGE WILL BE CONSIDERED.
- Names of children whose fees are in arrears will be struck off the rolls after the 15th day of the month and transfer certificates will not be issued until all outstanding amounts are cleared. In case the child wants to continue, fresh admission has to be sought. Children for whom fees have not been paid upto date may be prevented from sitting for school or public examinations.
- (a) No refund shall be made if advance fee paid is higher than a month's fee for students who are withdrawn during the school year, NO REMISSION IN FEES WILL BE MADE FOR A CHILD WITHDRAWN DURING THE COURSE OF A YEAR OR WHO IS ABSENT WITHOUT PERMISSION FOR ANY REASON.
- (b) NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF A CHILD WHICH IS TO TAKE EFFECT AT THE END

OF THE SCHOOL YEAR MUST BE RECEIVED BY FEBRUARY 15 OF THAT YEAR. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a liability in payment of fees in lieu of notice which will be equivalent to the Security Deposit applicable. Since places vacated during the school year mean a financial loss, this rule will be strictly enforced in all cases.

- (c) In case the child is withdrawn during the year, the final settlement of accounts including security deposit, will only be made one month after withdrawal of the child from the school, except in the case of students who have appeared for Board Examinations where the account will be closed one month after the results have been declared.
- 5. Cost of replacement will be charged for breakages, damages and losses.
- 6. All payments must be made by cheque, cards or Bank Draft drawn in favour of the HERITAGE ACADEMY, payable in Modinagar. In a covering letter, the parents must always quote the child's admission number. However, electronic fund transfer is acceptable.
- 7. The fees payable are subject to change from time to time. Parents will, however, be informed of any change in fees in advance.
